

## **Phase 3: Instructor Training Bootcamp**

This seven-day phase of Instructor Training focuses on preparing instructor candidates to become teaching assistants in Modules 1–6. Under the guidance of the instructors, trainees role-play and practice teaching all of the procedures from Modules 1 through 6, with peer review and some videotaping for self-evaluation.

Instructor candidates are supported in developing their ability to demonstrate and describe the procedures in relation to anatomical landmarks, physiological indicators and contraindications, and protocols of care, as well as how to respond to questions they may be asked by students in the classroom who are working toward their Level-I certification.

Instructor candidates who successfully complete Instructor Bootcamp Training may then proceed to Phase 4: Supervised Student-Teaching Practicum.
